



IMAC EUROCUP PARITY RANKING CALCULATION RULE

The IMAC EuroCup is structured, every year, on several competitions organized by different Countries within the IMAC Europe perimeter. The total number of Europe International competitions offered may change each year.

To be eligible for the final Championship ranking, a pilot must participate to a minimum of three of the total offered. If a pilot participates to more than three competitions, the best three scores will be used to calculate the final ranking. The others will be dropped.

Points per contest will be calculated from the contest's results. The winner of each class (Sportsman, Intermediate, Advanced, Unlimited, and Freestyle) will receive 1000 points. The following competitor's scores will be a normalized score based on their final score respective to the winner's. EuroCup Points are rounded to the nearest whole number.

Example:

First Place:	6875	Points:	1000
Second:	6723		978
Third:	6145		894
Fourth:	5475		796

Therefore, it may happen that more than one pilot will win three different competitions and earn a basic 1000 points in each of them. In this case the rule below will be applied in order to determine the winner of the EuroCup Championship.

For EuroCup Championship final ranking calculation, at the end of the Championship, one additional point will be awarded for each contestant below your placement.

Example If you finish in 1st place and there are a total of 5 contestants, you will receive an additional 4 points for a total of 1004 points. The normalized scores would also receive one additional point for each contestant below their placement.

In this case, Pilot B will win the first place of the EuroCup for the year in the respective Class.

The same rule will apply to discriminate potential parity situations also to the second and third place to be assigned in the EuroCup Championship in each Class.
