

IMAC WORLDS 2026 ARGENTINA BULLETIN 1

¡Bienvenidos a Argentina!

Dear amigos from all over the world.

The LATAM Region is pleased to inform you all that the IMAC World Championship is happening, and it will be held in Argentina.

The dates are April 1 through the 4th, 2026.

Here's the information you might need to plan your travel here and join us:

Alta Gracia, Province of Córdoba:

The World Championship will be held at the Alta Gracia Aeroclub, situated in Alta Gracia, province of Córdoba.

Córdoba has an international airport, which is located 50 minutes away from Alta Gracia and the hosting airfield. Alta Gracia is a highly touristic city as safe as it gets, with an approximate population of 65,000 inhabitants. There are many accommodation options available nearby, exceeding 20 hotels and a variety of lodging options. An ample set of culinary experiences is ready to match any taste from around the world.

We will have transportation arrangements for transfers to and from the international airport upon arrival and departure.

Venue:

The venue is an active manned aerodrome

The main runway is an active manned one, spanning 1.1km (1760 yards)
We have a pre-approved NOTAM available to stop manned air traffic to host the IMAC worlds.

There are available hangers with security and TV monitoring to store aircraft and ancillary equipment since weeks before the contest

The Argentinian team is ready to receive containers from abroad carrying competitors' gear and transfer them to a safe place within the Aeroclub of Alta Gracia grounds.



There will be 2 flight stations. One is going to be located at the north end of the main runway, and the second one is going to be located at the south end. Each station will have 2 overlapping flight lines for a total of 4 airborne competing airplanes at all times.

Travel dates:

We expect pilots will travel to Argentina with their own primary and maybe secondary

competition planes and, depending on the information provided to us by each competitor, we

will adjust logistics to receive and store the plane on the scheduled date of arrival. We suggest competitors arrive at least 5 days in advance, so they have enough time to adjust to

the time zone and be able to do practice flights during the weekend, and maybe some deserved

tourism too.

Note: The earliest arrival date will define when the NOTAM will be enforced.

The IMAC Argentina BOD is working the hardest for you to have the greatest time in Alta Gracia, near Córdoba.
